ACAENA

saccaticupula

zones 5–7 · ○ ACASA

Flat-mat groundcover, to 4" tall, with feathery blue-gray leaves and topped with large fruitlets in late summer.

ACHILLEA

Yarrow



ageratifolia

zones 6–8 · ○ ACHAT

Delicate, deeply cut bright silver leaves. 6-10" rock garden plant, with white flowers in summer.



ssp. ex Utah

zones 4–8 · ○ ACHUT

Small mats of ferny green prostrate foliage, with light yellow flowers rising 1-2" above the foliage in summer. For

interesting diversity include this in the alpine garden or trough.



x kellereri

zones 3–8 · ○ ACHKE

Finely cut, very silvery foliage combines with good white flowers on 6", upright stems in May-Aug.



x lewisii

zones 4–8 · ○ ACHLE

Ground-hugging alpine form with fuzzy gray-green foliage and pale yellow flower clusters on short stems in early summer.

ACINOS

alpinus

zones 5–8 · ○ ACIAL

Excellent plant for dry sunny locations. Red-violet flowers on 5-6" stems, June-Sept.

AETHIONEMA

Persian Stonecrop

antitaurii

zones 6–9 · ○ AETAN

6" shrublets of blue-gray leaves topped with pink flower clusters in summer.

cordifolium

Lebanon Stonecress

zones 5–7 · ○ AETCO

Plants grow to 8" tall, with blue-green foliage that is needle-like in appearance. The small rose-colored flowers are produced on upright terminal racemes and are showy for many weeks in the spring.

grandiflora

zones 4–9 · ○ AETGR

6-8" long blooming plants with soft pink flowers on fine gray-blue foliage. Nice rockery plant requiring sandy, well drained soil.



kotschyi

Stone Cress

zones 3–8 · ○ AETKO

Compact evergreen to semi-evergreen, dwarf sub-shrub. Rich pink flowers to 4" June-July.

membranaceum

zones 6–8 · ○ AETME

Blue-green cushions of foliage bear rich pink flowers June-July. Grows to 6”.



schistosum

zones 6–9 · ○ AETSC

Linear blue-gray leaves with fragrant flowers that are dark pink in color and bloom from terminal racemes in early spring. Grows about 4” tall. Questionably hardy to zone 5.

ALCHEMILLA

Lady's Mantle

faroensis 'Pumila'

Dwarf Lady
zones 3–8 · ○ ● ALCFP

This Faroe Island native has a nice 6-10” mat-forming habit with very dark green foliage and yellow flowers in spring. Quite shade tolerant but less drought tolerant than its cousin *A. alpina*.

ALLIUM

Chives

Deer won't eat chives.

cyataphorum var. farreri

zones 6–9 · ○ ALLCF

Red flower clusters above thick, upright leaves in May-June. Grows to 14” tall.

carinatum ssp. pulchellum

zones 3–9 · ○ ALLPU

Rose-pink bobbin-like flowers on 10-12” stems June-July. From the southern Alps.



cyaneum

zones 3–9 · ○ ALLCY

Neat tufts of grass-fine leaves, with clusters of cobalt-blue flowers on 6” stems.



flavum

zones 3–9 · ○ ALLFL

Loose clusters of dangling pale yellow umbels on 8-10” stems in late spring. Foliage is grass-like and edible. Native of Europe and West Asia.



'Mt. Sinai'

zones 3–9 · ○ ALLMS

12-14” tall with lavender-purple flowers that are larger than a silver dollar. Long blooming, from July thru Sept.



thunbergii 'Ozawa'

zones 3–9 · ○ ALLOZ

12” stems carry clusters of 1-2” brightly-colored, round-shaped purple flower heads into early Nov. Foliage turns tawny orange.

ALYSSOIDES

Bladderpod

utriculata

zones 5–9 · ○ ALYUT

Rock garden plant with green, ground-hugging foliage and 8” stems of yellow flowers in May-June. Attractive seed pods in autumn.

ANACYCLUS

Mt. Atlas Daisy



depressus

zones 6–9 · ○ ANADE

4-6” mats forming white daisies with purple backs in late spring. Needs good drainage.

ANAPHALIS

Pearly Everlasting

alpicola

zones 5–9 · ○ ANAAL

This 6" diminutive hardy alpine hails from the mountainous regions of Japan. The lovely, tufted, grayish woolly foliage is topped with white and reddish-rust flowers between June and August. Needs excellent drainage.



margaritacea

zones 4–9 · ○ ANAMA

Attractive white-gray foliage with white flower heads on 10" stems in Aug.-Sept.

triplinervis

zones 4–9 · ○ ANATR

This 10" tall, silvery gray alpine looks exceptionally attractive in July-Sept., when the foliage is topped with dense corymbs of pearly white blooms. An excellent fresh or dried cut flower.

ANDROSACE

Cushion Primrose

lanuginosus

zones 4–8 · ○ ANDLA

Silvery foliage in tight mounds that are covered by soft pink blooms in summer. One of the most "growable" androsaces.



'Millstream Hybrid'

zones 3–6 · ○ ANDMH

2" foliage forms very tight mounds and in early to late spring pretty pale pink flowers with a yellow throat appear.

septentrionalis 'Stardust'

zones 4–8 · ○ ANDST

4-6" pure white flowers in spring. Reputed to be a reseeding annual, we've been dividing for three years.

ANTENNARIA

Pussytoes

neglecta var. gaspensis

zones 3–7 · ○ ○ ANTNG

Tiny 2" gray carpets flowering pink in spring. Needs good drainage!

parviflora

zones 3–7 · ○ ○ ANTPA

Flat mats of tiny silver-gray leaves bear pinkish, pussy toe-like flowers on 3-4" stems. Flowers late April-June.

ANTHYLLIS

Kidney Vetch



vulneraria

zones 5–9 · ○ ANTVU

From the Balkan mountains, mats of green foliage bear large clover heads of yellow-orange May-June. Grows 6-8".



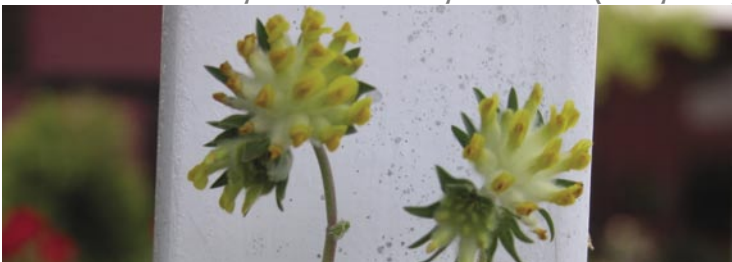
vulneraria ssp. var. coccinea

Red Kidney Vetch

zones 6–9 · ○ ANTCO

Low-growing, 6-8", with dramatic, unique orange blooms from early to midsummer.

ANTIRRHINUM

sempervirens

zones 5–8 · ○ ANTSE

Hardy, alpine snapdragon with white blossoms on 6" stems in summer. Attractive evergreen foliage is silky and hairy.

AQUILEGIA

Columbine

glandulosa

zones 3–8 · ● AQUGL

Tidy, dwarf form, growing only 8" tall, with large deep blue blooms in late spring.

flabellata var. pumila 'Selection'

zones 3–8 · ● AQUPS

Compact form, to 8" tall, with white spurred, bright blue blossoms in late spring.

saximontana

zones 3–8 · ● ● AQUASA

2.5" alpine bearing clusters of slightly crinkled, bluish green leaves and lavender-blue flowers with short spurs late spring to early summer.

ARABIS

Rock Cress

Very easy to grow. Spreads vigorously in any freely drained, sunny position. Keep well watered and sheared back after flowering to keep neat and compact.



blenpharophylla 'Spring Charm'

zones 4–7 · ○ ● ARASN

8" stems bear rose-pink flowers in spring.



caucasica 'Compinkie'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● ARACO

5-6" compact and prostrate pseudo-evergreen plant. A profusion of pretty pink flowers sit atop the foliage in spring.



caucasica 'Snowball'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● ARASN

Darling fat little 6" alpine bush with white flowers in spring.



ferdinandi-cobergii 'Variegata'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● ARACV

Flat green and white mats with 4-5" tall white umbels in spring.

procurrens 'Glacier'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● ARAPG

Dark green flat mats with 4-6" white flowers in April-May.

ARENARIA

Sandwort

ledebouriana

zones 5–8 · ○ ARELE

Dense cushions of deep green foliage topped with bright white blooms in summer. Very dwarf, growing only 2" tall.

balearica

zones 4–7 · ○ ● AREBA

Tiny bright green leaves forming a mat with myriads of tiny white flowers dancing on thread-like 1" stems. Tolerates sun but grows best in light shade or cool sites.

tetraquetra

zones 7–8 · ○ ● ARETE

Low dense mats of 2-4" four-angled stems with white flowers a half inch above the foliage from May-June.

ARMERIA

Thrift or Seapinks



juniperifolia

zones 3–8 · ○ ARMJP

Compact tufts of juniper-like, gray-green foliage bear lavender-pink button flowers in spring.
