

**juniperifolia 'Alba'**

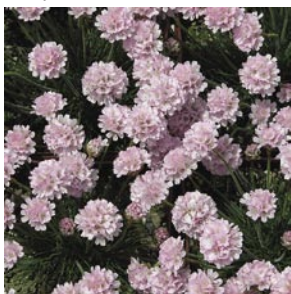
zones 4-8 · ○ ARMJA

2" alpine thrift has compact gray-green tufts that are covered with tiny buttonballs of white flowers in spring.

**juniperifolia 'Bevan's Variety'**

zones 4-8 · ○ ARMBV

A much loved alpine thrift. Virtually stemless, globular pink flower heads appear on 3-5" dark green, grassy mounds in early summer.

**juniperifolia 'Rosa Stoltz'**

zones 4-8 · ○ ARMRS

Tiny, grass-like tussocks of dark, evergreen foliage bear myriads of pastel lavender, button flowers on 3" stems in late spring to summer and often again in fall.

ARTEMISIA**Wormwood****caucasica (assoana)**

zones 5-9 · ○ ARTCA

Slightly aromatic 1", prostrate, silvery foliage with 3" greenish, spherical flowers.

genipi

zones 5-9 · ○ ARTGE

3-4" gray felt-like, mat-forming cushions with yellow flowers June-Sept.

**'Tiny Green'**

zones 5-9 · ○ ARTTG

New diminutive alpine, 2-3" high, with mat-forming gray-green foliage and tiny yellowish button flowers in summer. An especially worthy gem to plant in the rockery or trough.

ASARINA**procumbens (Antirrhinum procumbens)**

zones 5-8 · ○ ASAPR

Fragrant, hardy snapdragon with light yellow blooms with a darker lip throughout the summer. Dwarf, only 4" tall.

ASTER**alpinus**

zones 4-9 · ○ ● ASTAN

This alpine aster blooms in late spring with lavender-blue daisies centered yellow on 6-8" stems. Nice rockery subject.

alpinus 'Albus'

zones 4-9 · ○ ● ASTAS

10-12" stems, with white daisies in June.

alpinus 'Dark Beauty'

zones 4-9 · ○ ● ASTDB

Compact habit with 12-15" stems bearing 2" violet-blue flowers in June. Great for rock gardens and edging.

alpinus 'Happy End'

zones 4-9 · ○ ● ASTHE

Compact foliage with pink-lavender semi-double flowers in June. Mound forming. Grows to 12".

amellus 'Rudolf Goethe'

zones 4-9 · ○ ● ASTRG

15-18" stems are capped by violet daisies in late summer. Nice for cutting.

ASTILBE

Plume Flower

simplicifolia 'William Buchanan'

zones 3–8 · ○ ● ASWBW
6" spikelets of creamy white in late July-Aug. Very curly and dense foliage of dark shiny green.

thunbergii var. fujisansensis

zones 3–8 · ○ ● ASBFU
Pretty little rock garden form. 6-8" tall with congested, deeply cut foliage and creamy white blooms in July-Aug.

x crispa 'Perkeo'

zones 3–8 · ○ ● ASBPO
8-10" dark rose flower spikes in July. Nice dwarf hybrid from Germany.



'Royal Red'

zones 3–8 · ○ ● AUBRR
Grows just 4" tall. In early spring, the mat-forming, spreading evergreen foliage is covered with varying intense shades of magenta, red and purple flowers. Ideal for the rockery.

AUBRIETA

Purple Rock Cress

'Argenteovariegata'

zones 3–8 · ○ ● AUBAR
2-4" mat-forming evergreen with creamy white variegated foliage and intense blue flowers in spring.



'Royal Blue'

zones 3–8 · ○ ● AUBRB
Prostrate rockery or wall plant bearing flowers in various shades of blue, lavender and violet in spring.



'Whitewell Gem'

zones 3–8 · ○ ● AUBWG
Spreading 6" evergreen mats of gorgeous violet-blue flowers in April-May.

AZORELLA

trifurcata 'Nana'

zones 5–8 · ○ AZONA
Compact, creeping plant that forms hard mats of glossy green rosettes, following every contour of the surface.

BELLIS

English Daisy



perennis 'Dresden China'

zones 3–8 · ○ BELDC
A profusion of half inch double pompoms of baby pink appear on this 6" compact English daisy in spring.



perennis 'Rob Roy'

zones 3–8 · ○ BELRR
Deep green foliage and lovely deep crimson flowers in spring. Compact form, growing 4-6" tall. The best Bellis to grow.

BLEPHILIA

Wood Mint



ciliata

zones 4–8 · ○ ● BLECI
Grows to 2' tall with ovate leaves up to 3" long and spike-like bluish purple flowers, more rarely white, in May-Aug. Usually found growing in dry woods.

BUPHTALMUM

Sunwheels

salicifolium

zones 5–8 · ○ ● BUPSA
10-20" stems bear yellow daisy flowers all summer.

CAMPANULA

Bellflower



cochleariifolia 'Bavaria Blue'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● CAMBB
Excellent dwarf cultivar which flowers most of the season. This dark blue, compact form reaches only 4-5". Great for the front of the border, in rock walls, or used as a pot plant!



cochleariifolia 'Bavaria White'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● CAMBW
A spreading evergreen, this 4-5" dwarf selection provides a profusion of open, pure white, bell-shaped flowers throughout the summer season. Great for the front of the border, in rock walls, or used as a pot plant.

fenestrellata

zones 3–7 · ○ ● CAMFE
Sweet starchy, intense blue flowers with a touch of white above compact, small, hairy foliage June-Aug. Grows to 4"

portenschlagiana 'Birch Hybrid'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● CAMBH
Strong growing, 6-8" dwarf Campanula, with an extended bloom period. Pale blue bells June-Sept. Tidier grower than C. portenschlagiana.

portenschlagiana 'Lieselotte'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● CAMLI
An alpine plant found by Pierre Bennerup on one of his travels across the pond. Growing just 6" tall, this creeping bellflower clone produces lavender-purple flowers in late spring.



portenschlagiana 'Resholt Variety'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● CAMRE
Creeping alpine plant, to 6" tall, with panicles of large lavender bells throughout the summer.



poscharskyana 'E.H. Frost'

zones 3–7 · ○ ● CAMEF
4-6" fast-growing, trailing groundcover, with nice white flowers in May and June. Tuck into a wall to cascade. It flourishes in the poorest of soils.

raddeana

zones 3–7 · ○ ● CAMRD
Floriferous violet-blue bells May-June. Grows to 6".

CAREX

Sedge

'Beatlemania'

zones 5–9 · ● CARBM
Dark green fine-textured leaves edged in gold. Mop headed appearance forms clump up to 24" across but only 6" tall.

bergrenii

zones 5–9 · ○ ● CARBE

Loose tufts of short, blunt, blue-green, metallic gray to reddish brown, 2" long leaves with small brown flower spikes. Great trough grass.

caryophylla 'The Beetles'

zones 5–9 · ○ ● CARTB

Soft dark green leaves growing 3-4". The inflorescence is inconspicuously held tight in the foliage.

CENTAUREA

Cornflower

bella

zones 5–8 · ○ CENBE

Rose flowers above attractive tufts of foliage heavily white felted beneath.

CENTAURIUM

erythraea

Feverwort

zones 5–8 · ○ CENER

Native to Europe this is an annual or biennial plant found all over Europe in damp meadows, forest clearings and sandy soils. The stem is 6-18" tall and branches near the top. The basal leaves are ovate and grow in a rosette. The rose pink flowers are funnel-shaped to star-shaped and grow in cymes. It blooms June-Sept.

CERASTIUM

Snow-in-the-Summer

candidissima

zones 5–9 · ○ CERCA

Dense, silvery-white cushions topped by bright white blooms in May-June. Flat-growing, to 6" tall.



alpinum ssp. lanatum

zones 3–7 · ○ CERAL

Low-growing, 2-4", spreading alpine with flat, woolly gray leaves and white star-shaped flowers in summer.

CHAENORHINUM

Dwarf Snapdragon

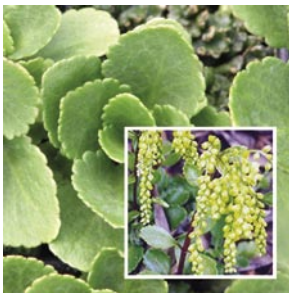
organifolium

zones 6–9 · ○ ● CHAOR

Small, growing to 10", with hairy leaves and pale purple to white snapdragon blooms in summer.

CHIASTOPHYLLUM

Cotyledon



oppositifolium

zones 5–8 · ○ ● CHIOP

A long blooming ornamental alpine. 6-8" drooping sprays of bell-shaped yellow flowers hover over nicely scalloped, succulent, rosette evergreen leaves in late spring to early summer.

COREOPSIS

Tickseed

alpina 'Alba'

zones 4–9 · ○ CORAA

Cute, little Coreopsis with delicate white composite-type flowers.

CORTUSA

matthioli 'Alba'

zones 5–9 · ○ CORMA

Pure white primrose flowers on 12" stems above tidy rosettes of deep green foliage in summer.

matthioli ssp. pekinensis

zones 4–6 · ○ ● ● CORPE

Small primrose relative for cool, moist shade. Heart-shaped softly hairy leaves in low tufts. 6-9" stems bear pendants of pink bell-shaped flowers in spring.

COTULA

minor

zones 4–8 · ○ COTMI

Flat 1" mats of miniature ferny foliage with little yellow button flowers in summer. Native of New Zealand; rare in cultivation.

CRASSULA

peploides

zones 5–7 · ○ CRAPE

This alpine variety forms aggressive mats with 1" small white flowers.



sedifolia

zones 4–7 · ○ CRASE

From Basutoland, dense pads of congested rosettes, formed by
